GUIDELINES

Be yourself! A personal voice is very important in this format. Blog posts should be conversational and share your point of view. This is not an academic article or a label in a gallery. If you are a student or emerging scholar interested in contributing a research-based article, consider submitting an essay to the ICAA's [Working Papers](#).

Posts should be relevant to the ICAA. We're interested in hearing from faculty and students using Documents Project in the classroom, artists represented in our digital archive, and international fans of the ICAA.

Posts can be submitted in English, Spanish, or Portuguese, to be published in English and Spanish. Submissions should be no longer than 600 words.

Posts are due four weeks before the desired publish date to allow for editing and translation. Email your content in a Word document to edonato@mfah.org. Posts should include:

- A suggested title
- At least 1 image, attached to the email
- Your full name and title

Liz Donato will review your post for overall tone and suggest edits where necessary. An edited version will be sent to the contributor for approval. After the contributor approves, the post will be sent for translation.
